Phonics checks 2025 timeline for teachers

Teacher activity

Start of the year

Teachers familiarise themselves with the phonics checks and related resources

Start of each term

Teachers plan for their term identifying which children will do the check and when

At check times

Teachers carry out a phonics check with their children at 20 and 40 weeks. The school uploads the results.

After each check

Teachers analyse and respond to the results with future teaching and learning

End of term

Teachers analyse the collated results in their school's summary report for insights
