Poutama Pāngarau

Poutama Pāngarau is a structured pāngarau approach developed for Kura Māori and Māori-medium settings. The approach is informed by the science of learning and aligned with the Pāngarau wāhanga ako. The approach is structured in Mata Ako - the key foundational knowledge at each Tau from 0 to 8.

Resources

The Poutama Pāngarau resource pack for Tau 0 to 8, includes ready to use teacher guidance and akoranga (lessons) activity cards that cover all Mata Ako. The resource packs are available now on Tāhūrangi.

Pāngarau Curriculum Resources

He Pīpī Pāngarau (Tau 0 to1)

He Pīpī Pāngarau is a collection of pāngarau readers that have been refreshed to support the new Pāngarau curriculum at Tau 0 to 1. The readers include kaiako support materials that explain how to use the resource, as well as hands-on activities for students.

The resources also include aromatawai tasks and recording sheets, to help assess ākonga against the updated Pāngarau wāhanga ako. The collection is also available on Tāhūrangi.

Tihei Pāngarau (Tau 4 to 8)

This collection of resources has been refreshed to support teaching and learning at Tūārere 2 and Tūārere 3 of the new Pāngarau curriculum. The collection covers all areas of Pāngarau, and includes six student books and their accompanying teacher guides.

Digital support materials have also been updated to include:

- 121 'Akoranga Matihiko', short videos explaining the key ideas in each lesson in each of the student books

- 66 'e-ako' modules which are student interactives to enhance the learning of key concepts in each chapter of the student books
- games to help students learn basic facts (Kēmu Meka Matua)
- a series of integrated problem-solving tasks called Rapanga Kōtuitui, for more advanced learners
- modules to help students learn how to use a spreadsheet to record data and produce data displays, called Akoranga Ripanga Matihiko
- games, tools, and spreadsheets of pre-prepared data to accompany the Tauanga books (statistics and probability).

All of these resources are contextualised in Te Ao Māori, and in types of activities that students can relate to, such as sport, travel, hui, managing money, and food.

Taku Whare Pāngarau (Tau 7 to 8)

This new resource uses Pāngarau in everyday activities that ākonga are involved in, in the context of a marae setting for Tau 7 and Tau 8. The collection includes an ākonga workbook and an accompanying kaiako guidance book for both Tau 7 and Tau 8. The books are available on Tāhūrangi:

He Tau Anō Te Tau

This resource is a refresh of three books from He Tau Anō Te Tau collection. The books focus on Te Tau (number) and Te Tauanga (statistics) for Tau 2 to 5. Each of the three books is accompanied by a corresponding teacher guidance book.

The books are designed for mokopuna and feature activities set in meaningful, real-life, and imaginative contexts that reflect the students' cultural and life experiences. These activities support various classroom uses, including teacher-led lessons, group work, independent learning, and reinforcing or extending knowledge of Pāngarau.
